

A Level Results - Thursday 13th August 2020 8.30 - 11.30 am

Dear Student

Firstly I would like to thank you for your hard work over the past year; I am sure that this will be reflected in your results. On Thursday, 13th August 2020, the day that results are released, the academy will be open for Year 13 students to collect your results.

In order to collect your results, you should use the main entrance at Armthorpe Road to access the academy before coming into the main hall to collect your results envelope. You will then exit the school via the Student Information Desk (SID) and walk around the main building towards the gates.

We will also need you to attend at a set time to ensure we have minimal numbers of people on site at any one time.

You should bring only one other person into the building with you, again to reduce the number of people on site.

Please wait in the marked areas outside of the main entrance prior to entering the building.

If you are not able to collect your results in person and are sending someone else, that person must have a written letter from you giving consent. In the letter you must name the person who is collecting the results and that person must also bring in some photographic ID.

No results will be released without signed consent.

The grades submitted by the academy were reached following a rigorous standardisation procedure which involved a range of teachers, Head of Department and Subject Director'.

On results day there will be an opportunity to meet with a member of the Post 16 team or Careers Inc if you wish to do so. You may have decided that you would like to have the opportunity to sit your exams personally. There will be an opportunity to do so in October and teachers will be able to discuss your options with you to decide on the best course of action.

Should you have any textbooks at home, results day would be an ideal opportunity to return them. We will have boxes available for you to deposit any books that you may have.

From the 27th November 2020 you will be able to collect your official examination certificates. Please ensure you collect in person, from the academy, as we require you to sign for receipt. If you are unable to collect them in person then the person acting on your behalf must have a letter of consent written by you naming them, and they must bring a photographic ID with you. If your certificates are available any earlier, the date will be published on the Academy website and on social media.
