Areas the classes cover:

- Speaking, Listening & Communication - Presenting ideas to an audience, taking part in formal and informal discussion.
- Reading – Comprehension, understanding & extraction of information from common everyday texts, such as newspaper articles reports and emails.
- Writing – Produce common formats like letters & emails, using accurate, spelling, punctuation & grammar.

Is the course accredited?

Yes, by City & Guilds. English sessions work towards an accredited qualification by City & Guilds. On successful completion of the course you will receive a certificate.

What's next?

Learners can progress from the basics to Level 2. (GCSE level). This is the level required to progress to advanced study and/or most entry level courses/employment.
