

March Post 16 Strike Action Provision

Dear parent/carer,

As you will already be aware, Wednesday 15th March and Thursday 16th March 2023 will be the third and the fourth days of industrial action taken by teachers belonging to the National Education Union. As a result Outwood Academy Danum will close to years Y7, 8,9,10 unless they form part of the vulnerable cohort in which case a member of the Inclusion Team will contact you as those students will be expected to attend the provision on offer for the strike day. All Post 16 students will be expected to attend the Academy on Wednesday 15th March and Thursday 16th March 2023. Transport across sites will run as normal with students still accessing transport at 07:45 and 10:30 as normal to attend AM and PM lessons.
