Dear Parent/Carer,

The results day for GCSE students is fast approaching, and I am writing to let you know how students will collect their results.

The GCSE result collection is on **Thursday the 25th of August**. Since we are in the middle of building work, students will not be collecting their results from school. Instead, students will need to come to the **Doncaster Knights' rugby club at Castle Park**. Students can collect their results between the hours of 9.00am and 11.00am from the clubhouse suite. If students cannot collect their results in person, they can request for another person to collect on their behalf. In order to do this they will need to bring in a signed letter from the student naming the person who will be collecting the results on their behalf. The person collecting will also need to bring in photographic proof of their own identity, i.e. passport or driving licence. Alternatively, the school can arrange to post their results home if this is requested.

Staff will be on hand to support students in the morning, and to answer any questions about their results and what that means for college and sixth form applications, along with queries about potential re-sits in maths and English for some students.
