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Preparation

As well as revision it is important that students:

• Arrive for the examination on time.

• Are hydrated and have had a good breakfast before coming to school. This will help with their

concentration.

Attendance

During this mock examination period it is critical that Year 11 students attend school on time each day.

Morning exams

Students with a morning exam should arrive at school shortly before 8:15am and join their teachers in the

main hall. After breakfast is served in the assembly hall, students will remain in the main hall for an exam

briefing. Exams will commence promptly at 9:00am in the Sports Hall .

Afternoon exams

To accommodate the afternoon exams, Year II will have their lunch between 12.00pm - 12.30pm. Students

who have an afternoon exam will meet in the main hall at 12.30pm for a briefing before a 12:45pm start.

Students who do not have an afternoon exam will go to normal timetabled lessons.

Thank you for your support. It is important that students experience the full formal exam conditions during

these mock examinations so they are familiar with them, and gain confidence and resilience tackling some

relatively long papers.
