Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to invite your child to our Year 7 transition days. Our transition days are Tuesday 12th, Wednesday 13th and Thursday 14th July. Your child should arrive at school for 8.20 am and will finish at 2.30pm. They will need to enter through the Leger Way entrance, next to the footbridge. Your child should wear their primary school uniform. A sandwich lunch and snack will be provided on all three days, but your child is welcome to bring their own lunch if they wish.

Please complete the slip below and hand it in to your child's primary school, to let us know if you will come to collect them. If we do not receive this information we will assume your child is ok to leave and walk on their own. Due to the building work there are no car parking facilities at the school apart from Blue Badge holders. Car parking is available at Castle Park rugby club and then you are able to walk round to the school entrance on Leger Way. There is no entrance to the school from Armthorpe Road. However, if your child has a disability or a severe injury at present, then please let school know via the enquiries email address.

On Tuesday morning, students will watch our school performance of Matilda, they will meet with the Principal, take a tour of the school and then sit a short online literacy test in order to assess the need for any interventions. The results of the literacy assessment will be made available to you.

Also on Tuesday we will hold a short open evening from 3.15pm-4.45pm. The Principal will give a short talk about the school and will explain the exciting new building work going on. There will be a chance for you to meet with some senior members of staff including our Special Education Needs Coordinator (SENDCo). On Wednesday and Thursday your child will have the chance to experience a wide range of lessons from English and maths to music and drama. They will also need to bring a PE kit on these days as there will be sports events on our school field.
