Dear Parent/Carer,

Move to Remote Online Learning for Year 9 Wednesday the 13th of December

Outwood Academy Danum are experiencing very high levels of staff absence that is both teaching and support staff. Unfortunately we have had to make the very difficult decision to move to online remote learning for **Year 9 on Wednesday the 13th of December in order to keep all children safe and supported.** I recognise that this adds an extra burden to parents and if we could avoid it, we would. As a parent of school age children myself, I understand that this doesn't come without impact at home, but have had to make this decision as the staffing levels we have does not adequately cover the teaching, support and duty gaps we have. The school has managed to buy in some external supply teachers, however this has not been enough to cover the staff absences that we are experiencing, with heavy absences in the catering team, teaching team, support staff and leadership. Presently, we hope for a return to the academy on Thursday the 14th of December, however this is reliant on staff returning from sickness. We will be in touch with further details as we know more. We will continue to be open to vulnerable children to come into school for their learning support and you can expect a phone call from the inclusion and learning manager team about this.

Home Learning

Students can also log directly onto their google classroom for their subjects should they wish to continue with the work they are completing in lessons. Students should be up and learning by 8:25am, following their normal timetable, at the normal lesson times.
