



Relationship, Sex and Health Education - Parent/Guardian Opt Out

It is a statutory requirement that all schools deliver Relationship, Sex and Health Education (RSHE) lessons to their students.

At Outwood Academy Danum, these are delivered through weekly Life lessons. The intention of these lessons is to provide the students with knowledge and allow them to make informed choices about their future.

Year 7:

Year 8:

- Puberty
- Menstruation, Periods and Menopause
- Consent and Values
- The Law (Being Safe)
- Healthy and Abusive Relationships
- Sexual Abuse
- STIs, STDs and Contraception
- Childbirth and Responsibilities of Parenting





Year 9:

- Consent and Coercive Control
- Condoms and Safe Sex
- Consequences of Unsafe Sex (STIs)
- HIV and AIDs
- Underage Pregnancy (Options)
- Online Grooming

Year 10:

- Alcohol, Drugs, and Risky Sexual Behaviour
- Sexual Harassment and Sexual Violence
- LGBTQ+ and Different Types of Relationships
- Media, Pornography and Body Image
- The Law, Sex, and the Internet
- FGM, Honour Based Marriage and Domestic Abuse
- Cancer (Breast and Testicular Cancer)
- LGBTQ+ and Pride
