Dear Parent/Carer,

We are pleased to inform you that we will be holding our Year 11 Prom at The Earl of Doncaster on **Thursday 29th June from 7pm until 11pm**. It will be a fantastic occasion, and we want all students to have a great time. Attending the prom is a great privilege. A chance to celebrate the hard work, determination and successes of the students. On the evening, there will be a buffet provided, a free photo booth, a sweet cart, an arcade machine, an awards ceremony and a DJ. All photos from the photo booth are free and printed ready to take away on the night.

Outwood Academy Danum is committed to being an inclusive school. All reasonable adjustments will be made so that all students can participate in this event. Please contact Miss Chadwick as soon as possible to discuss any reasonable adjustments required for your child.

Students at Outwood Academy Danum behave impeccably, we expect all students who wish to attend out of school visits to maintain this level of excellent behaviour. Please note that no alcohol will be available or permitted at the event. Outwood Academy Danum is providing the appropriate insurance cover for this visit, however please note that any personal effects taken by students (e.g. mobile phones, cameras etc.) are not covered.

Whilst we want all students to have the opportunity to attend their prom, going to the prom is a privilege and not a right. Students who demonstrate good behaviour and good attendance will be able to attend. Those who do not have good behaviour or good attendance will not be able to attend, so please bear this in mind with any potential purchases you make. We will not be able to reimburse any parents who purchase things for the evening in the event that your child cannot attend due to poor behaviour. However, in February, we explained the behaviour and attendance thresholds to all students and began a fresh start to ensure a fair chance for every student. Regular attendance is imperative if students are to achieve the greatest outcomes. Pupils are expected to achieve a 95% level of attendance from February half term until their exam period as a requirement to confirm their attendance at the event. Students are also requested to maintain a high level of effort in their lessons and demonstrate a positive attitude towards their studies.

The cost per student is £25.00 and all payments made are non-refundable. The deadline set for all payments is Thursday 25th May as we have to confirm our numbers with the venue, there will be no extension on this deadline.

Please note that as we are now a cashless school, we no longer accept cash or cheques in school and therefore payment will need to be through your iPay online account. If you have yet to set up your iPay account, please email finance@danum.outwood.com for the details you will require.
