Dear parents/carers,

I am writing to provide a Year II update as we head into this final half term before the summer exams. It was wonderful to see so many students attending the booster sessions in the academy over the half-term break, and to see parents and carers with students at our revision evening just before the holidays. It is wonderful to see our community coming together to do the very best for our young people to ensure they are well prepared for their exams and the bright future that awaits them.

I hope that you have reviewed your child's Praising Stars 3 certificate that was shared just before the end of the half-term. Your child received their certificate detailing their effort and predicted grades in each of their subjects, the certificate can also be found on the Outwood portal via your mobile device. <u>Portal.outwood.com</u> What they do from now onwards can really make a difference.

Over the next two weeks, Year 11 students will complete their mock examinations. This is an important milestone in experiencing how exams will operate and importantly for us to review their performance and target our final weeks of teaching and intervention to their personal needs. There is an overview of the mock exam timetable at the end of this letter, but all students also have their own personalised version, which has been shared with them.

With now only 46 school days until the first whole year group exam it is vital that we support students in forming good habits that evidence success:

- 100% attendance as every second of teaching and learning counts
- Punctual arrival to the Academy; on site by 8.15am every day exams cannot wait
- Absolute focus in every lesson
- Attend targeted after school sessions; they have been designed to fill the gaps students are missing and reinforce topics that students need
- Complete the weekly out of school tasks Mathswatch, Science GCSE-Pod, English daily questions, and many more activities across their examined subjects
- Have a revision plan timetable revision at home as well as the sessions in school; we will support building a revision timetable in school.

After school, there are targeted sessions for students to attend to help them revise key content, and help close any learning gaps. In the exams, every mark matters so we hope to see the students really capitalise on this time. We are also rewarding attendance at after school enrichment with weekly prize draws of ± 10 vouchers. There have already been over 50 pupils who have won a ± 10 voucher by being in the prize draws: all they need to do is to come to intervention to be in with a chance to win.

We want all students to have a vision of their next-steps; students have been working with specialist careers advisors looking at their career pathways in applying for 6th form, apprenticeships and college places. We recognise that places are limited in certain areas and we want to ensure your children are well prepared with applications and clear next steps.

Our sixth form has more applications than ever, with the introduction of T-Levels in health, students are already studying and working directly in the industry from the beginning. The next cohort will have the opportunity to study in our unique half-a-million pound Health education facility, opening September 2024. One of the first of its kind in the country and one of the most direct routes to working in the health industry. For many, a key part of the Year 11 vision is their prom, a rite of passage following their exams with the year group coming together to celebrate their hard work. - Attendance to targeted sessions- breakfast and lunch clubs, after school enrichment activities and holiday boosters.
