Dear Parent/Carer,

As we are nearing the end of our GCSE exam season, we are keen to support students to revise and study in the best way for them. At school, we are able to provide booster lessons specially prepared for their specific needs and the exams they still have to sit, along with staff to support them with their study in a school environment. These specialist sessions will be ongoing up until their final exam, and are important for reminding students of the key information. However, we are also aware that some students and parents are supportive of their child studying from home on aspects they would like to focus on, and have received a number of requests as such for this study time.

Therefore, from **11:45 am tomorrow the 16th of June**, students will be able to study from home coming into school for their remaining exams and any booster revision sessions they need to attend. This means that Y11 students will be free to go **home to study after 11:45am** tomorrow, the 16th of June unless they have their French exam in the afternoon, or their Spanish boosters to attend. I appreciate that this information will find its way to you at relatively short notice, but we are constantly refining and revising our provision and are keen to respond to the needs of our students as and when they arise.

Your child will attend a celebration assembly before they leave school escorted by their period 3 teachers.

Whilst we are supportive of effective home study, we do recommend that your child stay in school to study where doing so at home is difficult: we will provide study space and equipment to allow them to revise whilst at school. Just to reiterate, all students will be classed as being on study leave when at home preparing for exams, unless you and your child request otherwise. If they are staying in school, they will notify staff, who will register them and escort them to the study zones. When there is no exam, but coming into study, all students will be expected to sign in at reception each morning as they arrive to study with us.

Please can I ask that if you are requiring your child to stay at school from now until their final exam until 2:30pm every day, you let l.harle@danum.outwood.com know in an e-mail, or phone the attendance line on the usual number so we can collate this list of students.

We look forward to seeing the students collect their exam results in the summer. We hope that hard work and determination will see them succeed. Thanks for the ongoing support.
